COURSES: The following courses will be offered for Session 1 and Session 2:

Geometry (A, B, or C)
Algebra 1 (A, B, or C)
Algebra 2 (A, B, or C)
US History (A or B)
World History (A, B, or C)
Economics
Government
Earth Science (A or B)
Biology (A, B, or C)
English 9 (A, B, or C)
English 10 (A, B, or C)
English 11 (A or B)

Students may take up to 2 courses per session (1 for Block A and 1 for Block B), for a maximum possible 4 courses in the summer. Holt High School recognizes Summer School courses as credit recovery only. (Credit will only be granted for classes previously taken and failed.)

FORMAT: All courses will be online through E2020. Students will meet in the computer lab and work independently on the course(s) for which they register. In order to complete the assigned courses by the end of each session, students will be expected to devote time to the E2020 program on their own outside of class time.

SCHEDULE: Each class meets for 2 hours per day, for 12 days each session. (Monday– Thursday only. No Friday classes.) There are 2 sessions each day:
Block A: 8:30-10:30 a.m. and Block B: 11:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m.
* Students who miss more than 4 hours per class (2 days) or the Portfolio Night will **not** earn credit for the class and will not receive a refund.

CREDIT: Each class will carry ½ unit of credit (1/2 Carnegie Unit) toward high school graduation from Holt High School. (Equivalent of one trimester or semester) **To earn credit, students must earn a 70% or higher for their overall grade in the course.**

COST: Holt Students - \$100.00 per course*
Non-Holt Students - \$200.00 per course
* Upon successful completion of the course (passing grade of 70% or higher), Holt students will receive a rebate of \$25 per course. Holt students who qualify for free/reduced lunch during the school year are eligible for a reduced course fee of \$50 per course, with a \$25 rebate after completion with a 70% or higher. Out of district students are not eligible for a rebate.

REGISTRATION: Starts **Monday, April 26** at Holt Community Education Office - located inside Holt High School, 10-12 Campus. (Non-Holt student registration: May 10.) **Get enrollment packet from your High School Counseling Office.**

ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES

Contact your high school counselor for an enrollment packet and class recommendations for summer school. **Your school counselor's signature is required on your registration sheet.**

To enroll in Summer School, turn in all of the following from the enrollment packet:

Student Registration Sheet (triplicate) – signed by HS counselor

Emergency Card (orange) - signed by student and parent

Holt Summer School Policies Form (pink) - signed by student and parent

High School Transcript

Payment - Enrollment will not be accepted without full payment for all course(s). Cash, checks, and credit cards are accepted. Checks should be payable to HOLT PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

ENROLLMENT DATES -

April 26: Enrollment begins for current Holt Public Schools' students.

May 10: Enrollment begins for students attending other districts.

ATTENDANCE - Students are expected to be in class every day during their summer school session. Vacations, doctor appointments, driver's education, etc. should be arranged outside summer school hours.

Please note:

Students exceeding 4 hours of missed class time per session will be dropped from the course, not earn credit, and not be eligible for any refund.

MANDATORY PORTFOLIO NIGHT – On the evening before the last day of each session, there will be a “Celebration of Learning” event. This is an important event that all students are required to attend – dressed appropriately and accompanied by a parent/guardian and a sibling or friend. (More detailed information will follow.) **Students who do not attend the required Portfolio Night and meet the required criteria will not receive credit for Summer School and will not get a refund.**

REPORTING FOR CLASS -

Session #1: Report for class on MONDAY, JUNE 28th

Block A - by 8:30 a.m. Block B – by 11:00 a.m.

Session #2 - Report for class on MONDAY, JULY 19TH

Block A - by 8:30 a.m. Block B – by 11:00 a.m.

MATERIALS: Students are expected to bring the following to summer school each day:

Pen/pencil, paper, headphones, and calculator (if taking a math course).

LATE REGISTRATION – Late registration may be possible under special situations or unavoidable circumstances – if there is room in the class, but NO LATER THAN 8:30 a.m. on JUNE 28TH for first session and JULY 19TH for second session.

WITHDRAWALS – No refunds will be given for withdrawals after June 29TH for first session and JULY 20th for second session.

CLASS SIZE - Each lab will hold a maximum of 25 students, and we can have no more than 2 labs per block. So early registration is recommended.

TRANSPORTATION – Transportation is not provided for the summer school program.

GRADUATION/DIPLOMAS - Any HHS Senior planning to finish graduation requirements through summer school will not be issued their diploma until the HS counselors return in late August.
